CABERNET SAUVIGNON

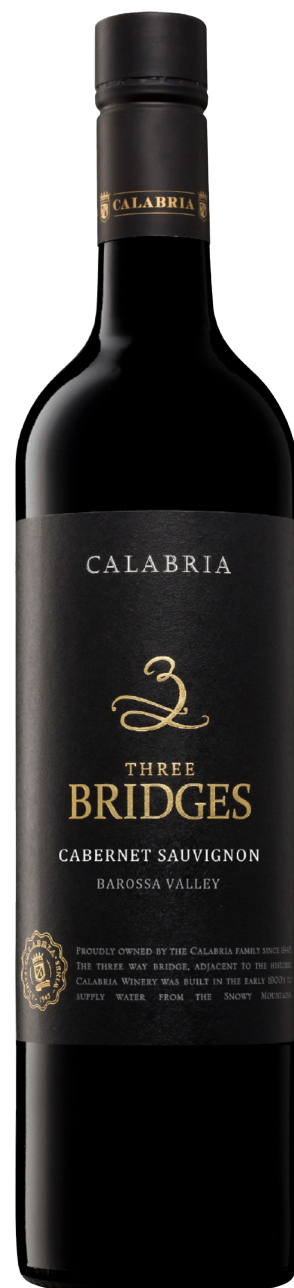
Vineyard & Region: Barossa Valley

Colour: Intense deep red with a crimson edge.

Bouquet: Fragrant with an array mulberry fruit, blackcurrant and a cedar nose.

Palate: A full bodied smooth palate with big notes of ripe fruit and five spices integrating with vanillin oak, providing complexity, ensuring a well balanced, mouth filling and flavoursome finish.

Additional Comment: 3 Bridges, adjacent to the historic Calabria Winery were built in the early 1900's to supply water from the Snowy Mountains via the Murrumbidgee River. Winemaker Bill Calabria has produced this premium Cabernet Sauvignon from specially selected parcels of high quality fruit.



Further Information

Serving suggestion: Ideal accompaniment to roast meats, lamb shanks with fresh herbs including thyme, rosemary and sage. Enjoy also with vintage cheddar cheeses.

Maturation: The wine is 100% Barrel matured for 12 months in French Oak Hogsheads & Barriques.

Cellar: This wine is perfect to drink now but will age in the medium to long term.

Alcohol Volume 14.5% | pH: 3.6 | TA: 6.8g/l | Residual Sugar: 2.7g/l
