BAROSSA VALLEY: The Calabria Family's Barossa Valley vineyard is located in the heart of the region and is named after Bill Calabria's first granddaughter; 'Sophie'.

Soil comprises of sandy loam red clay and limestone with a Barossa classification of 'Survivor vines' and 'Old Vines' (35-70 year old)

BOUQUET

Refreshingly bright rose with highlighted pink hues in colour. Liberating aromas of juicy red apple combined with fragrant raspberry and strawberry notes.

PALATE

A well-crafted blend of Shiraz, Grenache, Mourvedre and a touch of Pinot Grigio, create an alluring Rosé with subtle complexity. The palate conveys freshly cut apples and succulent red forest berries. Smooth, yet tight and crisp, this light bodied wine is highlighted by a gentle, savoury dry finish.

FOOD ACCOMPANIMENTS

Enjoy slightly chilled on its own with Italian antipasti tapas or be creative with Asian infused dishes such as coconut prawn curry.
