SHIRAZ *McLaren Vale*

Vineyard & Region

Fruit sourced from the highly acclaimed McLaren Vale region, approximately 35km south of Adelaide in South Australia. Notable for being one of Australia's top maritime regions, McLaren Vale's thin soils, limited water, and warm summers harness Shiraz's natural vigor and produce intense flavoured fruit.

Colour

Deep red with purple hues.

Bouquet

An intensely aromatic wine with a fragrance of violets, spice, black pepper and anise aromas together with buttery vanillin oak.

Palate

Rich and concentrated with intense fruit character and oak flavors: Fleshy, supple middle-palate with fine grained tannins and a persistent length

Winemakers Comment

This wine is bold and assertive. A tribute to the McLaren Vale style with elegant berry fruit and plenty of persistent oak to carry the wine. Ready to drink now, or cellar for several years.
